A big thanks to Steve Myers for opening up Skunk River Restorations in Ames to the club, even though conditions for the event were far from ideal. Rain all day, with occasional sleet/hail/snow and cold temperatures. We also had several volunteers that were not using the dyno that came to help out. They were doing everything from helping in tech, to weighing cars, to pushing water out of Steve's shop. It was a long day, as it started at 8 am and ran till about 5:00 in the afternoon, and with the weather, all the help was welcome.

All said, we had a total of 17 cars go across the dyno to get classed for the TT series. Additionally, there were five or six other folks that came just to get signed up for their license.

Results varied widely, from 105hp Miatas, to 485hp Mustangs of Matt Thompson, and a 445hp Camaro of Steven Fuller's. The loudest car of the day was Frank Ferrari's Firebird that he built just for the TT series.

I doubt there will be another dyno day, this year at least, but if anyone does need a session, please contact Steve Myers at Skunk River Restorations. He provides this and many other services for all kinds of cars.

Steve also let everyone wander around the "warehouse". It is full of classic British sports cars, Mustangs, Race cars, and a couple of really cool exotics, as well as Steves NP01 prototype.
