ANOTHER SPRING, ANOTHER STREET SURVIVAL SCHOOL! BY FRED BELL

Spring is on its way, and we're headed for a new venue yet again for our next iteration of the Tire Rack® Street Survival teen driving safety course. We'll do the spring Street Survival at DMACC's Ankeny campus on Sunday, April 28. DMVR will be teaming up again with Iowa Chapter BMW CCA to put on this valuable community service.

Street Survival continues to be the best way for teens to learn a lot more about car control and accident avoidance than driver's education ever can provide. Target age for participants is 15-21; students must either have a driver's license or have held a learner's permit for at least half of the period required before licensing by the state of issue. We also accept students who are north of age 21 if we have room – sign up as described below and we can work with you to get into the course as we see how registration counts are going.

Check out www.streetsurvival.org for more information about the program. The site includes a very good video showing how the training is done in the student's car by a trained instructor on a closed course. Students learn what it feels like when the car is about to lose traction, and learn how to avoid or correct from such situations. It's always an excellent prep for winter driving or gravel roads in lowa. Additional demos include seeing the force of an airbag detonation and seeing the limitations on a semi driver's vision.
